

The Recyclability Story

"Recyclability", established in 2015 as a community recycling program, is an inclusive volunteer based Social Enterprise involving people of all abilities, encouraging reuse and recycling.

Recyclability helps our clients develop skills and confidence, preparing them for future employment and other volunteering roles and provides many other social benefits. Recyclability encourages reuse and recycling, impacting positively on the environment!

Our volunteers undertake tasks such as weekly kerbside collections, letter box drops and sorting of items for regular "Stuff" sales and for our Op Shop.



Our Recyclability Op Shop (Retail Shop) is based at 4 Percy Street Echuca. Surplus items are sold to local businesses and commercial recyclers.

Volunteering Opportunities

Volunteering opportunities are available to clients of Community Living & Respite Services Inc, with support provided according to individual needs.



Community volunteers are also needed to assist with the ongoing sustainability of Recyclability in all areas of the program including:

- Kerbside Collection
- Collecting donations from clothing donation bins
- Maintaining the Recyclability Shed
- Retail - Op Shop & Rag Sales
- Administration

Kerbside Collections

Kerbside Collections occur each week in Echuca or Moama. Expansion into other towns is planned. Recyclability Volunteers distribute up to 800 flyers each week to homes on a rotating basis, and return the following week to collect any donations or clothing, manchester, toys, books and small household items.



Clothing Donations Bins

Clothing donation bins are located in Echuca in the following areas:

- Nish Street Car Park (near the arcade)
- High Street Car Park (behind Cotton On)

Coming soon to Moama, Rochester, Tongala and Kyabram. Some of our Donation Bins have been painted colourfully by our Club Teen program.



Bags of Rags

Bags of Rags are also available for purchase - great for tradespeople, cleaners and for home use! 5kgs bags for \$15. Rags can be customised to your needs, and delivered to your business.



Op Shop

The Recyclability Retail / Op Shop is located at 4 Percy Street Echuca.
Opening Hours 10am - 3pm Thursdays & Fridays and other times as advertised.

The Op Shop has a range of items for sale at affordable prices including:

- Books
- Toys and much

All revenue raised from the Recyclability Program is used to sustain the program, which is providing valuable opportunities for people with disability in our community.
